Re: Phoenix Academy – Covid-19 update

Firstly, may I apologise for the lateness in my response to you. I have been waiting on further information and guidance from Public Health England.

I can now update you that I have now been advised that the academy is safe to re-open on Thursday 22nd October 2020. However, due to a localised increase in the numbers of people being advised to self-isolate, there are a number of staff who are unable to return on this date, and as a result I have taken the decision to keep Phoenix Academy closed until Monday 2nd November 2020 (after half term break).

May I take this opportunity to thank all parents/carers and pupils for actively engaging in the home learning that has been provided – it has been lovely to see work being uploaded via DoJo's, Purple Mash and Twitter, and I am excited to see this continue for the rest of this week.

Obviously the safety of staff and pupils is paramount to the academy and I will continue to follow advice and change practices as required to meet the ongoing government guidance. If changes are due to occur, I will endeavour to notify you quickly.
