SEND REFORM - WHAT THIS MEANS FOR WALSALL FAMILIES

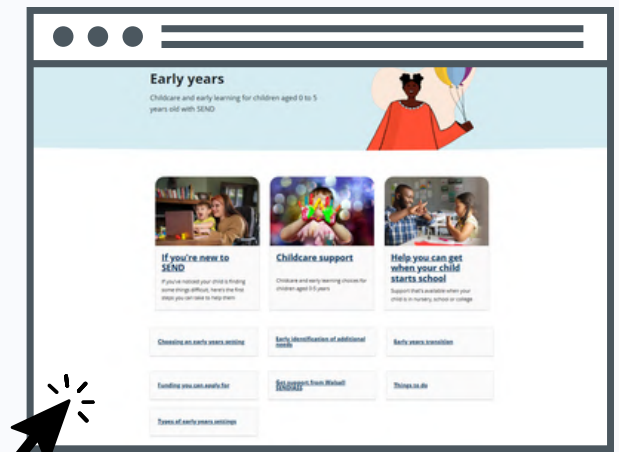
LOCAL OFFER IMPROVEMENTS - YOU SAID, WE DID

In response, we have reviewed the Early Years section, updated the content, and added three new pages:

- **Early Years Transition**



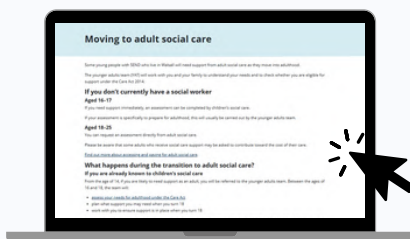

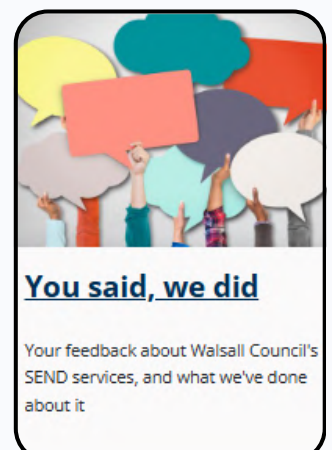

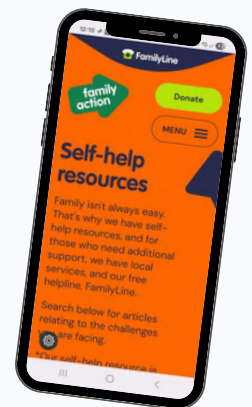

SENSORY BAGS

These have been supplied by Sassy Sensory Surprises, a local provider involved in HAF (Holiday Activities and Food Programme) and Short Breaks.



KIDS EAT FOR £1

Various restaurants and cafes are joining the 'Kids can eat for £1' again this summer. Here is a list of places that are involved and their offer:

- **Morrisons Cafe** - Feed the Family for £15 - 2 Adult Meals & 2 Drinks for £15 - 2 kids eat free on top.
- **Tesco** - Free Kids hot meals with any adult full price food purchase.
- **Asda Cafe** - Kids' meals available for just £1 . No minimum spend.
- **Sizzling Pubs** - Kids' main meals for £1 Monday–Friday (12pm – 7pm).
- **Brewers Fayre Pubs, Table Table & WhitBread Inns** - Unlimited breakfast: Up to two kids eat free with every adult breakfast (£10.99).
- **Beefeater Pubs** - Kids eat free unlimited breakfast, two kids per paying adult.
- **Harvester** - Kids' meals for £1 with and purchase of an adult main.
- **Pizza Hut** - Free kids' buffet (unlimited pizza, pasta, and salad) daily until 3pm during summer. Requires a £10 adult spend.
- **TGI Fridays** - Kids eat free all day everyday with the purchase of an adult main at TGI Fridays. Sign up to loyalty programme.
- **Dunelm Cafe** - Kids eat free when an adult spends at least £5 after 3pm.
- **Yo! Sushi** - Kids eat free during school holidays. Requires a £10 minimum adult spend.

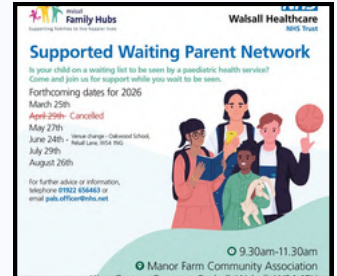
The supported waiting partnership network meetings will be running every month where there will be guest speakers to advise on a variety of monthly topics and many services who support with access to additional support for you and your child.

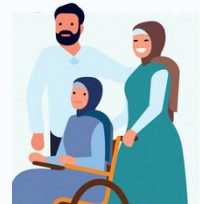

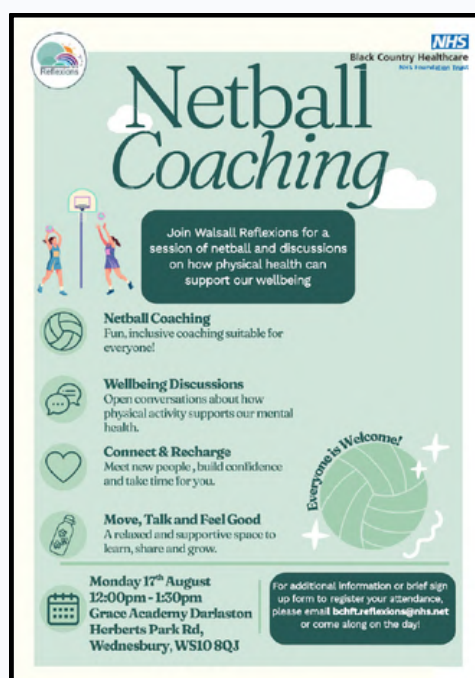

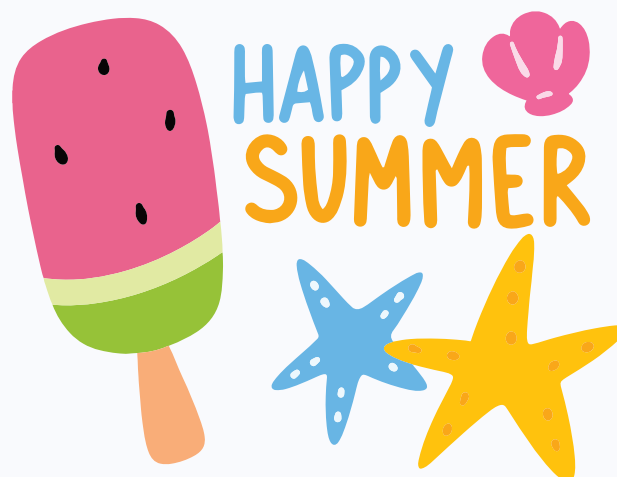
